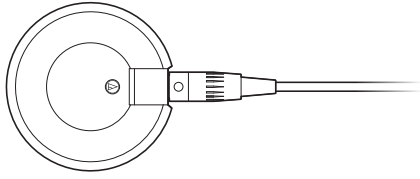

- Heavy die-cast case and non-slip rubber bottom pads minimize coupling of surface vibration to the microphone
- Low-profile design with low-reflectance finish for minimum visibility

Cautions for the product

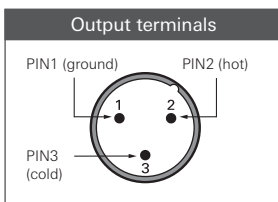
- Do not subject the product to strong impact to avoid malfunction.
- Do not disassemble, modify or attempt to repair the product.
- Do not handle the product with wet hands to avoid electric shock or injury.
- Do not store the product under direct sunlight, near heating devices or in a hot, humid or dusty place.

Notes on use

- The microphone should be placed on a flat, unobstructed mounting surface. The sound source should not be below the plane of the mounting surface.
- Audio-Technica has developed a special RFI-shielding mechanism, which is an integral part of the connectors in the UniPoint® line. If you remove or replace the connectors, you may adversely affect the unit's RFI immunity.
- Placing any object on a surface (such as a conference table) before its finish is fully cured may result in damage to the finish.

Connection procedure

Connect the output terminals of the microphone to a device that has a microphone input (balanced input) compatible with a phantom power supply. The output connector is an XLRM-type with polarity as shown in the figure below.



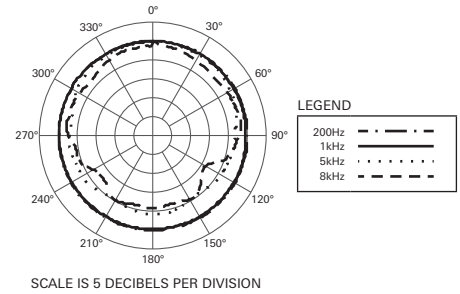
This product requires 11-52 V DC phantom power.

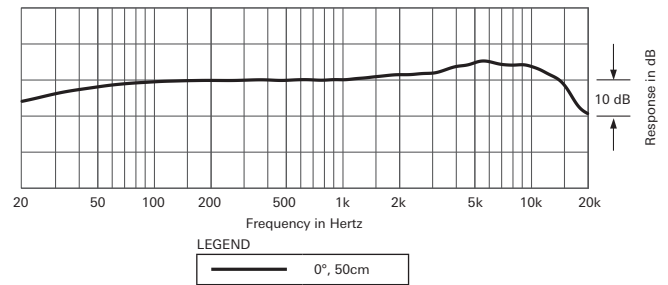

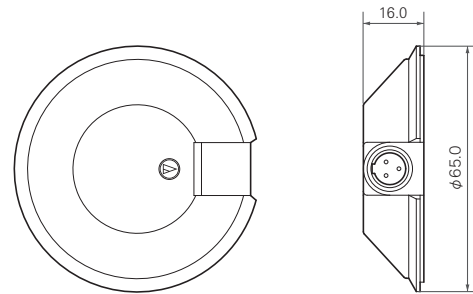
Polar pattern



Frequency response

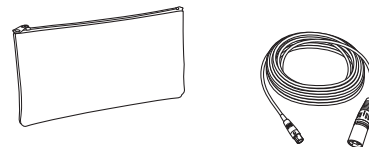
